- 4. Prematurity and intrauterine growth retardation
- 5. Perinatal suffering and the approach to asphyxiated newborns
- 6. Diseases of pregnancy impact on the newborn (endocrine diseases, hypertension, platelets diseases autoimmune etc.)
- 7. Pathophysiology and treatment of hypoglycemia and neonatal jaundice
- 8. Exposure to drugs or substances harmful to the newborn
- 9. Genetic issues that may arise at birth
