6. Diseases of pregnancy impact on the newborn (endocrine diseases, hypertension, platelets diseases autoimmune etc.)
7. Pathophysiology and treatment of hypoglycemia and neonatal jaundice
8. Exposure to drugs or substances harmful to the newborn
9. Genetic issues that may arise at birth
