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#### Aims

##### **Knowledge and understanding**

To acquire theoretical knowledge about the concept of continuity of care throughout the childbirth process, with particular attention to the relationship between the woman and the healthcare professional during all stages. To understand current regulations and best practice recommendations for accurate and compliant clinical documentation.

##### **Applying knowledge and understanding**

To apply the theory of continuity of care in practice, establishing a continuous relationship with the woman throughout the entire childbirth process, ensuring personalized and continuous support. To correctly use disciplinary language in clinical documentation, following guidelines and current regulations.

##### **Making judgements**

To autonomously assess the effectiveness of continuity of care, identifying areas for improvement in the relationship with the woman and the delivery of care. To document critically and in compliance with the guidelines, ensuring the quality and accuracy of the recorded information.

##### **Communication skills**

To communicate effectively with the woman, the healthcare team, and other professionals, ensuring continuous information sharing and support throughout the entire childbirth process. To use technical language to produce clear, comprehensive, and compliant documentation.

##### **Learning skills**

To develop the ability to update and expand knowledge and skills in managing continuity of care and clinical documentation, participating in training courses, simulations, and practical reflections.

## **Contents**

Observation and documentation of the assistance and care pathway during pregnancy, delivery and puerperium of 2 women/couples (according to Midwifery Case Load Model)

## **Detailed program**

The student:

- recruit the woman/couple during the first trimester of pregnancy, according to indication of Degree Course
- participate with the woman/couple in appointments during pregnancy, birth and the first weeks of the puerperium, according to Time Bands recommended from Guidelines;
- document the pathway according to forms provided by Degree Course;
- draw up "Observed Midwifery Care", the Case Report, the Epicrisi
