Aims

The student must demonstrate knowledge of the main clinical indications for CT examinations of the chest and abdomen and the meaning and importance of the use of iodinated and liver-specific contrast agents. You must have solid knowledge of radiological anatomy and demonstrate mastery of diagnostic protocols in chest and abdominal CT. They must also have acquired the necessary skills regarding the definition of normality and pathology in the CT field of the organs and anatomical structures treated during the course.

Contents

The module aims to provide the student with the theoretical, technical and practical knowledge for carrying out computed tomography exams in the study of the chest and abdomen and the semiotics of the main pathologies.

Detailed program

- ? Main clinical indications for CT examination of the chest and abdomen
- ? CT of the chest and abdomen: introduction, indications, diagnostic protocols, normal picture and pathological picture.
- ? Chest: imaging of lung nodule, pneumonia and lung neoplasms.
- ? Liver: HCC, cholangiocarcinoma, metastasis, benign lesions
- ? Pancreas: solid and cystic neoplastic lesions, neuroendocrine tumors, pancreatitis
- ? Kidneys, urinary tract and bladder: lithiatic pathology, inflammatory pathology, neoplasms
