Aims

To describe the placebo phenomenon in relational terms and the mechanisms through which it acts

Detailed program

The difficult patient and personal narrative.

Interpersonal motivational systems (attachment, caregiving, predatory, competitive, sexual, play and affiliation, cooperative)

Attachment in the relationship with patients (secure, avoidant, ambivalent, disorganized attachment); attachment-

based care approach.

The placebo effect and implications for the relationship with the patient; the mechanisms through which the placebo effect acts

Traumatic experiences and their impact on mental functioning with a focus on the relationship with patients in conditions of increased vulnerability

Teaching form

4 lessons of 2 hours each, delivered in person. The module is based on a delivery teaching method (frontal lessons). During the lessons, the teacher encourages the active participation of students through classroom discussions and providing examples to stimulate critical thinking and encourage direct involvement in the topics covered, allowing students to apply the theoretical knowledge acquired to different healthcare fields. The module is delivered in Italian.
