Objectives of the course are:

- Teach the basic skills of Grant Writing
- Provide an overview of the Italian and European projects landscape
- Introduce basic strategies and tools to search for forthcoming calls (e.g. EU Funding&Tender portal)

The course is preceded by a lesson in which some aspects of contemporary science will be illustrated and

discussed, from excessive competition for research funds and academic positions, to the constant growth of publications, from the uncritical use of bibliometric indexes to ethically questionable behavior.

After the course, the candidates will be able to understand GW terminology and to approach a project proposal according to the standard sections required by most of the proposal templates, in particular:

- SMART Objectives
- Methodology including transversal aspects
- Workplan including Work Packages, Tasks, Deliverables, Milestones
- Impact
- Communication, Dissemination, Exploitation
- Project Management
- FAIR DAta Management elements
- Open Science Practices outline

## **Assessment method**

Assessment of practical exercises (either in presence or in remote attendance)
