- Make informed choices about Open Access publication and self-archiving (e.g. choosing the right journal and Creative Commons license for their project)
- Gain a better knowledge of Open Access services available in Bicocca

- Retrieve open access literature from the main subject specific repositories

Doctoral students, preferably, but not exclusively, at the end of their programme.

Assessment method

Lesson modules will be released every few days and can be consulted individually at any time.

Wrap up meeting: on June 19, h 14-16 p.m..

The meetings will be held in person; attendance is recommended, but will not be a requirement for the CFU. Slides will be provided for those unable to attend, with additional materials if needed.
