## **Breakdown of meetings**

The module consists of six 2-hour sessions, which can be broken down as follows:

1st session: analysis of the concept of environmental sustainability in relation to how it is understood in the ideological representations of the green economy, circular economy, decarbonisation, biodiversity enhancement and shared value creation.

2nd session: critical application of the concept of sustainability through philosophical analysis and socio-economic cases that challenge the achievement of SDGs 10 and 13: development, consumption and waste disposal; uncontrolled urbanisation processes and population concentration imbalances; intensive farming and cultivation and their social impact.

3rd meeting: The concept of ecology in relation to individual and collective behaviour within society.

4th meeting: The concepts of social value, vulnerability and autonomy.

5th meeting: The concept of care.

6th meeting: Analysis of a model of grassroots involvement in terms of equality and overcoming social discrimination: the ecofeminism proposal.
