Course title

New forms of inclusion in the information society

Topics and course structure

The course, organized at the Department of Human Sciences for Education of the University of Milan-Bicocca, includes lessons on the models of inclusion and participation that have developed in the digital communication. The debate on direct democracy, on the experiences of e-democracy or on participatory practices at the local level will be discussed within the broader dimension of contemporary reflection on the information society and on the tools of inclusion and participation available.

The course is divided into:

Three theoretical/introductory lessons and one meeting dedicated to case studies

Each meeting will explore a theme and concrete experiences of e-democracy and will be structured as follows: a part of frontal lesson and a part of interactive activity.

For those attending, mandatory readings will be provided for each seminar (articles or book chapters).

Objectives

The aim of the module is to provide direct knowledge supported by examples of some of the main experiences of digital democracy present in contemporary communication and the scenarios that have developed starting from the literature on the information society.
