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#### Course title

Inclusive education and teaching

#### Topics and course structure

The course examines the issue of disability from a social, cultural and educational perspective, with a view to highlighting the challenges and opportunities involved in teaching students with disabilities within secondary schools.

#### Objectives

Knowledge and understanding

- Knowledge of the cultural and theoretical underpinnings relating to disability;
- Awareness of personal attitudes towards disability;
- Knowledge of the historical evolution of perceptions of disability;
- Knowledge of the institutional framework relating to issues of inclusive education;
- Knowledge of the methodological foundations for developing an inclusive approach in schools;
- Knowledge of the relational dynamics involved in working with people with disabilities;
- Knowledge of the terminology and reference models of social models of disability.

- Recognise pathways to empowerment and support for people with disabilities;
- Recognise one's own approaches to disability;
