Aims

The course's programme and the practical tasks will provide medical students with the notions to correctly face up to female physiology and pathology, including physiological changes of fertility period and pregnancy-puerperium and obstetrical and gynaecological diseases.

Contents

The primary aim of this course is to allow medical students to acquire general notions of gynaecology and pathology in order to identify diseases, and to differentiate basic from severe ones, that is those that could require a specialistic intervention. For this purpose, the course's programme includes the study of: anatomy and physiology of female reproductive system, fetal physiopathology, obstetrical and gynaecological pathology (specific topics: diagnosis, treatment and prevention).
