Aims

Diagnostic principles and therapeutic approach to cardiovascular diseases.

Contents

During the course, the student must acquire adequate professional training in the cardiology field with particular regard to differential diagnostics and the setting of appropriate therapeutic pathways. Particular attention will be paid to gender relationship with the above mentioned argument.

Detailed program

The course aims to provide students with the practical tools essential to recognize signs and symptoms of cardiovascular diseases, to diagnose these diseases, to check for possible differential diagnoses and propose one or more therapeutic options. It is also proposed to provide the student with the necessary tools to interpretation of the most common laboratory and instrumental examinations, as well as the elaboration of a diagnostic plan therapeutic and follow-up of the main internities. During the Professional internship, the student must appropriate professional preparation in the cardiology field and its sub-sectors with differential diagnostics and the setting of appropriate treatment pathways.

In particular we will discuss arrhythmias (particularly bradiarrhythmias), internistic-cardiological diseases (particularly cardiac amyloidosis), cardiovascular prevention, chronic coronary syndrome and the dual antiaggregant therapies. Regarding gender, the objective is to analyze and evaluate with a medical and scientific approach and in a gender based view with the aim to improve not only the knowledge on aspects determining gender differences but also the appropriateness of medical intervention in order to give higher attention to anamnestic, instrumental and laboratory data in relationship to patients' gender.
