The epidemics that continue to follow one another (COVID-19, Monkeypox) have made it clear that at the origin of diseases, in particular infectious diseases, there is a complex interaction between man, the animal world and the environment. For this reason, for some years the World Health Organization has been promoting the "One Health" approach that takes into account all these factors in health policies. This theme then intersects with the theme of Global Health, an area of study, research and intervention policies that underlines the importance of people's health worldwide, countering the inequalities that often lead to it.
