Injuries and Occupational Diseases: From Diagnosis To Medical Certification

Aims

The purpose of the course is to deeply explore the aspects related to workplace injuries and occupational diseases. It focuses on a practical approach that guides participants from the initial diagnosis to the medico-legal requirements for any physician.

Contents

The medico-legal requirements related to workplace injuries and occupational diseases involve every physician. The course includes an in-depth exploration of this topic (epidemiology, updated legislation) and a theoretical-practical discussion of the necessary medico-legal requirements in case of workplace injury and occupational disease. The course includes a simulation of the completion of the required documentation and the discussion of clinical cases.

- Definition and characteristics of workplace injuries and occupational diseases
- Relevant regulations
- Medico-legal requirements in case of workplace injuries and occupational diseases
- Completion of first INAIL certificate, report, and information to law authority
- Presentation of clinical cases

Enrollment from the fourth year of the degree course in Medicine and Surgery

The lectures (7 hours) are conducted in a lecture format at the beginning, aimed at engaging students interactively in the subsequent part.

All activities are conducted in person.
