Aims

The course will provide the essential theoretical knowledge of the key diagnostic tests used for the clinical identification and management of cardiovascular diseases. The acquired knowledge will contribute to a better understanding of the major indications and clinical value of each diagnostic tool. The students will also learn how to interpret basic findings of test results and cardiovascular reports.

Contents

Clinical cardiovascular exam; electrocardiogram; chest X-ray; echocardiographic techniques; cardiac computed tomography; cardiac magnetic resonance; scintigraphy; positron emission tomography; invasive hemodynamics; electrophysiology study; cardiac angiography and intracoronary imaging

- Noninvasive imaging modalities: overview and selection
- Transthoracic echocardiography and lung ultrasound

- Stress and transesophageal echocardiography

- Nuclear imaging and positron emission tomography
- Invasive imaging and hemodynamics
