Aims

Provide students with an introductory, hands-on experience in Nuclear Medicine procedures and diagnostic techniques, fostering foundational understanding and clinical awareness.

Contents

Learning Objectives

By the end of the internship, students will be able to:

1. Understand basic principles of Nuclear Medicine and common radiopharmaceuticals.
2. Observe preparation and administration of radiotracers safely and according to protocols.
3. Participate in image acquisition procedures (scintigraphy, PET/CT).
4. Recognize indications and patient preparation for common nuclear medicine examinations.
5. Appreciate radiation safety principles and regulatory requirements.
6. Communicate effectively with patients regarding Nuclear Medicine procedures.

Detailed program

Day 1:

Introduction to Nuclear Medicine: history, principles, common modalities.

Observation of radiopharmaceutical preparation and quality control.

Shadowing during diagnostic procedures (e.g., bone scan, thyroid scan).

Basics of image acquisition and processing.

Day 2:

Observation of PET/CT procedures and case discussion.

Radiation safety briefing and regulations overview.

Interactive session on interpreting common nuclear medicine exams.

Wrap-up discussion and feedback.
