Learning objectives

**Knowledge and understanding*

Provide basic knowledge on sources of administrative authority organization, the limitations on agency actions, the agencies procedures.

**Applying knowledge and understanding*

Develop the approaches and methodologies for the analysis of administrative law

Independent judgment in the interpretation of legal norms and in identifying the most appropriate legal solutions.

Communication skills in presenting and discussing legal topics, both in written and oral form.

Ability to learn autonomously, including through the consultation of legal sources, academic literature, and case law.

Contents

The objective of the administrative law course is to study the administrative procedure and the activities of public authorities. Particular attention will be dedicated to the analysis of the problems that have arisen due to the deep transformations presently taking place in administrative law.

Detailed program

Public administration: rights and duties;

Administrative procedure;

Public administration power and subjective legal positions;

Administrative act and administrative measure;

Liability in public administration;

Notes on administrative justice: administrative and jurisdictional protection.

Prerequisites

Appropriate capacity in learning, writing and speaking, together with a general legal knowledge.

Teaching methods

1. Unless exceptional circumstances arise, and except as provided under point 2, lessons will be held in person. The initial part will follow a lecture-based format, while the subsequent part will aim to engage students in an interactive manner.
2. It is possible that certain specific lessons may be recorded and uploaded to the platform.
3. Additional meetings and seminars on specific topics may be organized with professors from other Italian or foreign universities.

Assessment methods

Oral exam. There may be one or more optional written test for attending students
