Assessment method

Written examination to check preparation on the examination syllabus:

10 multiple choice questions of Nursing in Psychiatry, 1 clinical case of Nursing in Psychiatry to be solved, 2 open questions concerning the module of Psychiatry, 2 open questions concerning the module of Psychology.

The test evaluation includes 3 points for each correct answer to the multiple choice questions for the Psychiatry and Clinical Psychology modules and up to 5 points for the open questions (cut-off 18 out of 32), and 2 points for each correct answer to the multiple choice questions and up to 12 points for the discussion of the nursing clinical case for Nursing in Psychiatry (cut-off 18 out of 32).

The final assessment is given by the weighted average of the individual modules
