Course title

Philosophy of joyful and diffused education

Topics and course structure

The course will help to discover the fundamentals of gay education (vitalist, libertarian and libertine philosophy), to place the proposals of gay education and widespread education in the contemporary panorama of educational culture and to support with readings, films and practical exercises the transfert of this orientation in activities and behaviors. It is a radical reading of educational institutions and culture which aims to totally rethink school, teaching and educational theories

Objectives

With this teaching, with a constant and participated frequency in the lessons and in the Laboratory connected to the course, it is intended to PROMOTE the following learning, in terms of:

Knowledge and understanding:

- Knowledge and understanding of vitalist philosophy, counter-education and widespread education
- Ability to relate knowledge and models that are differentiated in the philosophical field
- Applied knowledge and understanding:

- Ability to apply knowledge and models to suggested educational practices, in particular to widespread education practices

Autonomy of judgment

– Acquire and consolidate analytical and critical thinking skills in educational situations, taking reflective ethical and epistemological positions, characterized by professional responsibility.

Communication skills

Development of the ability to effectively communicate the logic and criteria of counter-education, joyful education and widespread education interventions

Learning ability

- Ability to re-elaborate and organize knowledge;
- Ability to identify methods and tools to support one's own and others' personal and professional growth.
