Learning area

Acquisition of linguistic skills in LIS, LIST, and Italian

Learning objectives

Knowledge and understanding

Understanding the modality of human language by comparing the processing of spoken languages and sign languages. Knowledge of theoretical and practical research methodologies for investigating registers, genres, and styles. Understanding the mechanisms of sociolinguistic variation (with a focus on variationist sociolinguistics), sign language policies, and the linguistic rights of Deaf and Deaf-Blind individuals.

Applying knowledge and understanding

Content: Ability to apply methods and digital tools for data collection, material construction, annotation (according to given guidelines), and detailed analysis of sign language (LIS) texts. Ability to formulate research hypotheses and analyze behavioral data, translating them into descriptive results (such as graphs and percentage distributions) to carry out fieldwork. Competence in drafting a scientific text/written paper applied to a concrete case study.

Making judgments

Ability to independently choose a research topic, formulate consistent hypotheses, and critically interpret both the data collected in the field and the resulting statistical distributions. Skill in evaluating and integrating the sociolinguistic theoretical framework with issues related to language policy planning and the protection of linguistic rights.

Communication skills

Ability to clearly communicate, in written form through a structured scientific text/paper, the findings of linguistic research along with its methodological and annotation data. Capacity to actively, equitably, and collaboratively participate in classroom group work, contributing to the shared construction of knowledge and constant interaction.

Learning skills

Development of learning skills oriented toward collaborative and "learning by doing" practices. Ability to autonomously expand one's expertise using scientific sources and digital materials.
