The course intends to explain the foundations of company law

Contents

The course deals with basic concepts of company law, with a brief introduction to enterprise law.

Teaching methods

A mix of hands-on teaching (recorded lectures, delivered asynchronously, along with multiple-choice questions)

and interactive teaching (in-person meetings) will be adopted. The former will focus on providing the fundamentals of corporate law, while the latter will seek to develop a more participatory learning process, including examining practical cases, possibly based on case law.

Assessment methods

The exam will be exclusively oral; there will be no midterm exam. The exam will focus on the content covered in class and illustrated in the reference textbooks, with the aim of assessing students' level of learning, their argumentative ability, clarity of presentation, and command of language.
