Learning objectives

1. Knowledge and understanding

Know the main areas of intervention and the institutional, community, and family contexts related to the field of elderly care.

Understand the specific features and challenges of social work with older adults, with particular attention to frailty, lack of self-sufficiency, loneliness, and the network of available services.

2. Applying knowledge and understanding

Apply tools and techniques for needs assessment in complex situations involving elderly individuals.

Develop and implement personalized intervention projects aimed at supporting frailty and enhancing individual, family, and community resources.

3. Making judgements

Critically evaluate the social, cultural, and institutional contexts and dynamics that influence the condition of older people.

Formulate intervention strategies based on ethical, legal, and professional principles.

4. Communication skills

Communicate effectively with older people, family members, caregivers, multidisciplinary teams, and institutions.

5. Learning skills

Recognize the need for continuous updating in response to the evolution of social policies and the needs of the elderly population.

Develop a reflective approach to one's professional practice, integrating theory, practice, and supervision.

Contents

During the lessons students will be accompanied in the knowledge of different areas and intervention projects of the elderly area.

The path through meetings with experts and educational outings, is an opportunity for reflection and comparison with respect to the role that the social worker can have in helping relationships with elderly people and their families, but also to promote individual group and community resources.

Detailed program

The course will address the following topics, adapting them based on the knowledge and interests of the participating students:

Socio-demographic and regulatory framework on aging.

Stereotypes and prejudices (ageism).

Social policies and welfare models in support of the elderly.

Active aging.

Elderly people and caregivers.

Dementia.

Social services and interventions for the elderly population: the role of the social worker.

Multidimensional assessment and personalized care planning.

Ethical and deontological aspects of social work with older people

Prerequisites

Sufficient educational skills in logic, social culture and reasonable capacities in learning, writing and communication

Teaching methods

8 lessons, each lasting 3 hours, structured as follows:

6 lessons divided into two parts: the first part will consist of traditional teaching (frontal lecture with theoretical framework), and the second part will involve interactive learning (exercises and group work).

2 lessons will be dedicated to educational field trips.

Assessment methods

The assessment of the workshop-based course, marked as “approved/not approved,” will be based on:

- the student's active participation in the proposed activities
- the level of knowledge and ability to apply the theoretical concepts presented in class
- technical and critical thinking autonomy in case simulations and practical exercises
