Aims

3. Making judgments

Critically evaluate the appropriateness, effectiveness, and overall impact of current prevention strategies and public health policies.

Communicate public health concepts and data using appropriate scientific terminology, demonstrating the ability to translate complex information into accessible messages for the general public.

5. Learning skills

Independently consult databases, epidemiological reports, and official institutional sources (e.g., WHO, national health institutes) for continuous professional updating on health guidelines and epidemiological trends.
