Aims

Understanding key principles and main methods for meta-analysis.

Contents

The course will describe the main methodological approaches to conducting meta-analyses in accordance with the PRISMA (Preferred Reporting Items for Systematic Reviews and Meta-Analyses) and MOOSE (Meta-analysis of Observational Studies in Epidemiology) reporting guidelines.

Detailed program

The course will cover the following topics:

- Introduction to epidemiology for neuroscience
- Literature search strategies and data extraction
- Effect size measures for evidence synthesis in meta-analysis
- Fixed-effect and random-effects models
- Assessing and addressing heterogeneity
- Publication bias and related issues
- Risk of bias and quality assessment
- Overview of statistical software for meta-analysis

The course is intended for PhD students in Neuroscience.
