Epidemiology and Health Tecnology Assessment

Aims

The course aims to provide students with the fundamental principles and key concepts of Epidemiology and Public Health.

Contents

Introduction to Public Health; the concept of health; healthcare demand and health needs; principles, concepts, and methods of epidemiology; principles and concepts of public health; public health strategies, including primary, secondary, and tertiary prevention; Health Technology Assessment (HTA).

Detailed program

The course covers the following topics: introduction to Public Health and the concept of health; healthcare demand and health needs; principles, concepts, and methods of epidemiology; epidemiology of the major diseases and their determinants; health information systems and data sources; principles and concepts of Public Health; public health strategies, including primary, secondary, and tertiary prevention; the role of Public Health within healthcare systems; financing and delivery of public health services. The course will also examine the main epidemiological methods used to assess population health and evaluate the effectiveness of healthcare interventions. In addition, students will be introduced to the principles and methods of Health Technology Assessment (HTA), with particular emphasis on the clinical, economic, organizational, ethical, and social evaluation of health technologies as a tool to support healthcare decision-making and service planning.
