Teaching Methodology in Nursing and Midwifery Sciences

Aims

To acquire skills in processes, methods and instruments for teaching-learning of lifelong learning in medicine for nursing and midwifery professional skill development.

Specifically:

Knowledge and Understanding

The student will understand the pedagogical and didactic principles relevant to nursing and midwifery education. Comprehend adult pedagogical processes in continuing education and acquire tools and methodologies for devising educational interventions in professional settings.

Applied Knowledge and Understanding

The student will apply methods and tools to design continuing education activities for peers and students, employ suitable teaching techniques to enhance learning in clinical-care settings, and implement educational strategies to advance the professional development of nursing and midwifery staff.

Independent Judgment

The student will critically evaluate training requirements in healthcare professional settings, determine the most suitable teaching methodologies based on objectives and the educational context, and identify factors that affect the efficacy of educational processes in clinical and organizational settings.

Communication Skills

The student will communicate proficiently during educational and tutoring sessions, employ clear and inspiring language while performing educational activities, and promote dialogue and the exchange of experiences during professional development meetings.

Learning Skills

The student will nurture the capacity for ongoing learning in new teaching approaches, combine theory with practical experiences to improve personal educational competences, and reinforce self-assessment and professional development skills within educational settings.

Contents

Subjects of the course are developed through the acquisition of skills in the processes, methods and tools for teaching and learning of nursing and midwifery discipline in theoretical and apprenticeship areas. The course enables student to develop skills in processes, methods and tools for teaching-learning of continuous training for the professional development of nursing and midwifery.

Detailed program

The teaching methods: Problem Based Learning (PBL), storytelling, Briefing-Debriefing, clinical skills laboratory and teaching assessment.

Prerequisites

Defined by the degree regulation.

Teaching form

Lessons are conducted primarily in a lecture format with the inclusion of some interactive activities (individual and/or group exercises, role-playing, educational videos, guided discussions). The lessons are held in person.
