Master Thesis



- individual work
- includes a mandatory curricular internship, or "stage"
- consists of a written document containing the original contributions or results achieved by the student
- written in **English**
- duration of **at least 5 months** full-time equivalent
- regulations available on <u>e-Learning</u> for the thesis and internship



Internship or Stage

- mandatory element of the thesis work
- it provides the internship credits
- **completely integrated** in the thesis work and in each thesis proposal
 - \circ it's not a do-it-yourself activity \rightarrow
- where: at the university consortium (Unimi, Unimib, Unipv), or at companies, organizations, research centres, or other universities, including outside Italy
- when: between the start and the end of the thesis work
- duration: at least 150 hours (may be more!)





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internship development



- The **evaluation** will take place in three moments:
 - after **40** hours of the internship (*)
 - after **75** hours of the internship
 - at the **end** of the internship
- The **evaluation criteria** and schedule shall be agreed between the tutors at the start of the internship
- At the end of the internship, the student shall upload a final report with its timesheet and a short summary
- The company tutor shall also upload a student evaluation
- (*) In the first evaluation, the student, the company or the university tutor can ask the Committee to cancel the stage, and a new internship, or even a new thesis, shall be selected




Additional internships



- additional internships may be done (before or after the mandatory one), provided that
 - they do not award credits
 - they interfere the least is possible with the learning process
 - they provide insurance coverage from the University
- may be used to close early the internship with credits for an **early acquisition**:
 - close the first internship after 150 h
 - add a second one until the end of the work

Thesis Supervision



- for each student, there will be:
 - a thesis supervisor ("relatore" in Italian) representing the university consortium, who is member of the AI4ST CCD
 - a company tutor ("tutor aziendale" in Italian) as supervisor of the stage activity
- additional supervisors may be suggested by the thesis supervisor as co-supervisors ("correlatori" in Italian)
 - the company tutor may be a co-supervisor as well
- if **the stage takes place in the university consortium**, the student will be supervised by two members of the University teaching or research staff (acting as a thesis supervisor and company tutor respectively)



Eligibility Criteria



- Three conditions have to be met for a student to start a thesis:
 - passing the exams for the courses of Advanced Foundations of Mathematics for AI, Advanced Foundations of Statistics for AI, Advanced Foundations of Physics for AI, and Advanced Foundations of Artificial Intelligence
 - passing sufficient exams to accrue at least **42 ECTS** ("CFU" in Italy)
 - having been admitted to the second year of the Master's programme



Thesis Proposals



- students my start a thesis work in two ways:
 - selecting one of the thesis proposals provided by the University Consortium, which have been crafted already including an internship activity
 - proposing a thesis theme, connected to an internship identified individually, to one of the members of the CCD or to the "Relations with the world of work, stage and external theses, and leaving guidance" committee (*).
 If the proposal is deemed adequate a thesis supervisor shall be appointed, and a new thesis proposal will be created
 - in all cases, THE INTERNSHIP SHALL NOT START BEFORE THE OFFICIAL START OF THE THESIS

Selection Procedure



- A web-based application is being developed by the Milano Bicocca technicians in order to handle the thesis proposal collection and the thesis selection process
- While the application is not operational, **temporarily**:
 - the thesis proposal lists are **available in** <u>e-Learning</u>
 - the thesis request shall be done in all cases by contacting the University Supervisor:
 - the official start date will be noted by the University Supervisor with an email to the student
- In all cases, a thesis shall start upon a mutual agreement among the student, the thesis supervisor, and the company tutor
