Application options and fees

Interested students may choose to apply for one of **three different options**:

- Option 1 | Study Tour:
 The Factories of Sustainability,
 will take place from 14 to 16 april, for
 a total of 3 days and 2 nights. For
 this option, the participation fee is
 € 320
- Option 2 | The Green Economy Festival, will take place from 17 to 19 april, for a total of 3 days and 2 nights. For this option, the participation fee is € 260
- Option 3 | Full Tour, will take place from 14 to 19 april, for a total of 6 days and 5 nights. For this option, the participation fee is € 580

Note: Travel expenses to reach the departure city (Parma), the Festival venue, are entirely at the participants' expense








The factories of sustainability
