The teaching hub hosts students of the following degree programs:

- □ 6-year master's degree in Medicine and Surgery, in collaboration with the University of Bergamo and the University of Surrey (UK).
- ☐ 3-year Health Professions bachelor's degrees:

 - Nursing
 - Obstetrics
 - Medical Radiology Imaging and Radiotherapy Techniques

The facility has three floors:

- ☐ **Ground floor**: administrative offices, tutors' and didactic directors' offices, office of the course director of the Medicine and Surgery degree program, standard classrooms (classroom 6 is dedicated to distance learning), study spaces, refreshment area with vending machines.
- ☐ **Floor -1:** classrooms for interactive teaching, simulations, and practical exercises.
- ☐ First Floor: standard classrooms, PBL classrooms, study spaces, refreshment area, tutors' and didactic directors' offices.

The facility is open Monday through Friday from 8 am to 6.30 pm

The facility is equipped with air conditioning. For it to work sustainably and efficiently windows and French windows must be kept closed.
