
PART I - GENERAL RULES AND ADMISSION CRITERIA

Art. 1 - Extra-EU Exchange Period

The University's Extra-EU Exchange Program is aimed at acquiring educational credits during an experience in a non-European country. The Extra-EU Exchange Program (hereinafter: Program) lasts a minimum of 30 actual days up to a maximum of 6 continuous months, renewable in the case of thesis preparation; for those enrolled in a Specialisation School or in a PhD Course (third cycle of study) the program must have a duration of at least 3 continuous months. The program must take place between 8 March 2023 and 31 October 2023 unless it is necessary to extend the research period for the preparation of the thesis.

The experience may take place in the following ways:

 Traditional Mobility (the entire period is carried out abroad in presence or in smart working; therefore students abroad, with the authorization of their destination, even if the activity is carried out in e-learning/smart working, are

PART I - GENERAL RULES AND ADMISSION CRITERIA

Art.1 - Erasmus Traineeship Program

The Erasmus Program is aimed at the acquisition of educational credits during a European experience for a maximum of 12 months for each cycle of study (cycle I: Degree; cycle II: Master's Degree; cycle III: PhD/Specialisation Schools). For Single-Cycle Master's Degree courses, the maximum is 24 months of mobility.

The Erasmus Traineeship Program (hereinafter: Program) has a minimum duration of 2 months (60 actual days) and must take place between 8 March 2023 and 31 October 2023. For those enrolled in a Specialisation School or in a PhD Course, the Program has a minimum duration of 3 months (90 actual days).

The experience may take place in the following ways:

- Traditional Mobility (the entire Traineeship period is carried out abroad in presence or in smart working; therefore students abroad, with the authorization of their destination, even if the activity is carried out in smart working, are considered in traditional mobility!
- Blended Learning (the Erasmus period is composed of a period in Italy in smart learning and a period abroad of at least 60 days in presence and/or smart learning).







FAQs #1 CAN I APPLY FOR TWO DESTINATIONS WITHIN THE SAME CALL?



- E.g.: if you want to spend 2 months in Australia and 2 months in Mozambico, YOU CANNOT DO SO applying to a single call

- E.g.: you asked for a 12CFU scholarship, but you like the place and you decide to integrate the 4CFU experience
- ANSWER YES YOU CAN... BUT YOU HAVE TO NOTIFY THE DECISION TO THE ERASMUS OFFICE AT LEAST ONE MONTH BEFORE THE END OF THE ORIGINAL STAY

FAQs #4 TWO DIFFERENT INTERNSHIPS ABROAD HAVE TO BE: ONE IN EU AND OUNE EXTRA EU, OR THEY CAN BE CARRIED OUT IN ANY COUNTRY?

> ANSWER YES, PROVIDING YOU APPLY FOR THE TWO SCHOLARSHIPS IN TWO DIFFERENT CALLS

> FAQs #5 DOES THE ERASMUS SCHOLARSHIP COVER ALSO THE INTERNSHIP FEES?

• E.g.: you take part in an intership where you are asked to pay some supplementary fees for supporting the research (e.g. fuel costs on boat trips)

> ANSWER NO, THIS LIND OF EXPENSES ARE NOT COVERED

FAQs #6 CAN A 6 CFU STAY AT AN EXTERNAL INSTITUTION BE ENOUGH FOR A THESIS PROJECT?

• E.g.: you collect only part of the data for your thesis which will be analysed once you are back in Bicocca

> ANSWER YES!

> FAQs #7 CAN I CUMULATE TWO DIFFERENT SCHOLARSHIPS?

- E.g.#1: you got an Erasmus scholarship plus a scholarship from EU-funded projects of the host institution
- E.g.#2: you got an Erasmus scholarship plus another scholarship NOT EU-funded

> ANSWER NOT IN CASE#1 AND YES IN CASE#2

FAQs #8 WHICH KIND OF CALL SHOULD I APPLY FOR IF I WANT TO SPEND A PERIOD IN A COUNTRY WHICH IS NOT GEOGRAPHICALLY FOUND IN EUROPE, BUT IT IS UNDER THE POLITICAL ADMINISTRATION OF A EU COUNTRY

■ E.g.#1: you want to go to Martinic or Bonaire

> ANSWER YOU HAVE TO APPLY TO A TRAINEESHIP CALL
